All children

- It is important that your child **attends school on time, every day**. Children who are absent will miss important learning time, and any children who arrive late in school disrupt the learning both for themselves and their classmates.
- **Reading is vitally important** to your child's progress so please spare the time to read with your child every day and ensure that reading bags brought to school every day (Please comment in the Reading Record book)
- PE kit (Black shorts/joggers, white t-shirt, pumps or trainers) should be kept in school and taken home at half term to be washed

Foundation Phase (Nursery, Reception, Y1, Y2)

Could parents please ensure that:

- Names are in all clothes
- Children read at home at least 3 times per week
- When collecting children at the end of the day please wait outside the fenced area
- Children are to only bring toys in when requested
- To encourage independence please allow Nursery children to walk into the classroom on their own
- If anyone else is collecting your child please let school know by phone or letter

- Please check your child's hair regularly for lice and treat appropriately
- All children are given free milk and fruit after morning break. If there are any medical reasons why your children cannot partake in this please let school know.

Juniors (Years 3, 4, 5, 6)

- Homework will be issued every Monday and will relate to classroom work. Pupils who return completed work by Tuesday will receive 15 Dojo points, 10 points by Wednesday and 5 Dojo points by Thursday. Homework must be returned by Friday or pupils will complete the work during playtime.
- We know that children have varying abilities, so will accept some variation in the quality and quantity of work. We would like parents to sign the completed homework so that we know that you have seen and accepted the quality of work.
